

## **Traffic Calming – Green 20mph Advisory Signs**

During our discussions with NNC Highways to reduce traffic speed they have asked if we wish to be part of a 20mph Advisory Speed Trial.

We are given a limited number of signs, placed in certain areas of Weldon, for a period of 32 weeks. The Parish Council is finalising details for signage to be up in time for the August Bank Holiday.

### NNC Highways Policy of an Advisory 20mph Limit states –

*Formalised 20mph speed limits tend to be contentious as well as emotive and the supporting evidence researched by the Department for transport is inconclusive in terms of the benefits delivered. In taking a pragmatic view, NNC therefore remains cautious in terms of implementing enforceable 20mph speed restrictions. However, temporary sign of an advisory nature, alerting or reminding motorists to exercise careful speed management in residential environments can have benefits and provide public reassurance for a local community.*
